Upgraded technology now allows for your pets to stay indoors while your security system is armed. Bosch Security offers a Pet Friendly Motion Detector with advanced technology that detects human intruders without generating false alarms for pets.

First Step Processing (FSP) adjusts the detector's sensitivity based on the signal amplitude, polarity, slope and timing. This technology can distinguish between signals caused by humans and signals caused by pets up to 100 pounds. Not only can it determine the difference between multiple pets, but it also ignores signals caused by rodents.

BATTERY POINT LIGHTHOUSE

December 10, 1856 the Battery Point Lighthouse first illuminated the north entrance of the Crescent City Harbor and for over 150 years has continued to be a community beacon. In 1965 the lighthouse was decommissioned, only to be reactivated in 1982 as private aid to navigation.

With its exposed location atop a rocky island the lighthouse takes a beating from waves, wind and weather. MENDOCINO FOREST PRODUCTS

Advanced Security Systems continues to work with Mendocino Forest Products and recently completed an upgrade to the existing fire alarm system in the Fence Line Building to a state of the art Bosch 7412GV3 fire panel, capable of protecting not only the large building, but additional shops if needed. By the most efficient means possible Advanced Security Systems worked with Mendocino Forest Products to ensure production was not slowed and the system was replaced unobtrusively.

Over a mile of

wire was re-run throughout the large building, taking a total of two weeks for two technicians. Keeping the large quantity of wire from obstructing the mill equipment, while working in the noisy conditions and staying out of the way were a few of the challenges for the technicians onsite. They were up for the challenge, satisfying the customer beyond their expectations.

Advanced Security Systems solved many of the ongoing issues around the fire suppression system Mendocino Forest Products was having, and now monitoring

the state-of-the-art system, protecting the mill from potential fire damage.
