Winter Safety Tips

- Have your heating system, water heater and any other gas, oil, or coal burning appliances serviced by a qualified technician every year.
- To prevent the risk of fire, NEVER leave a space heater on when you go to sleep or place a space heater close to any sleeping person. Turn the space heater off if you leave the area.
- When purchasing electric cooking products such as electric knives, slow cookers and food processors, look for the UL Mark. Manufacturers use the UL mark to demonstrate that a product meets specific safety standards.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHT

HUMBOLDT STATE UNIVERSITY COLLEGE CREEK APARTMENTS, ARCATA, CA

With record enrollment, it was time for Humboldt State University to offer additional housing and services to the growing population of the university. In August of 2010 HSU unveiled a state-of-the-art community. The 38 million dollar state bond project took two years to complete.

The complex houses a Market Place, NCAA Soccer Field, 15,000 square foot Community Center and is home to 438 students. Advanced Security Systems installed a Notifier Engineered Fire Life Safety System throughout with Auto Detection in each room as well as integrated the fire alarm system with the elevators to recall when there is an alarm. The newly in-

stalled system is connected to the existing Notifier Fiber Optic Network installed by Advanced Security Systems in 2001. This allows for the system to connect with every other fire panel on the campus as well as University Police full control to reset or acknowledge any signal received.

It was an honor to be one of the few local contractors to work on a project of this magnitude. Project Manager Scott Messina with John Richards performed the installation on time and on budget throughout the two year process. Not only did the pair work diligently on the installation but they also programmed, tested and



trained all those involved throughout the entire process.
